Gran and Madge make a whole plate of fudge.



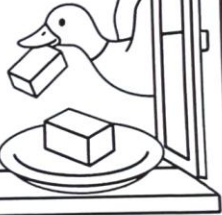
Can you move the fudge to the ledge? Do not set it on the edge.
